Think How does this effect my life?

Prop Finding a way for my heart to respond In the stage show Matilda the children sing 'When I Grow Up!' This song is filled with amazing and fantastical things that a child might wish to do when they grow up, including eat sweets everyday and watching cartoons all night. What wonderful things might you do when you grow up. Write a few ideas down starting with When I Grow Up...

I wonder what your parents would think of your list? What responsibilities stop parents from doing all the fun 'when I grow up' things? Does all this adult busyness mean that Parents don't love you or look after you? Why do you your parents put you taking care of you above all things?

Read Isaiah 40:12-14 and 28-31

God asks Isaiah lot's of questions to show all the things God knows, does and holds in his hands.

But who does God consider and love first and foremost?

Read Psalm 8:3-4. The writer remebers that God holds all the stars in their place, yet knows him, loves him and looks after him. God is never to busy for you! Whatever we are going through God cares. So what do you want to share with God today? Have a quiet moment and bring your worrys to God, in your head and heart, and as you do know he cares. In that still moment, see if you can feel God with you. Talk to your mum or dad after your quiet moment about how it felt.
